Program emphasis Master's scholarships

In cooperation with the Siemens Regional companies and German universities, we enable highly qualified students from Central and Eastern Europe, Asia and Latin America to participate in Master studies at a German university.

To further expand this commitment, Siemens and the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) agreed on two projects in 1999: the "DAAD/ Siemens Scholarship ASIA 21st Century" and the "DAAD/Siemens Initiative for Young Engineers from CEE".

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Program emphasis Master's scholarships S

For qualified young people from focus countries

- 2-year Master's scholarship also in cooperation with DAAD
- 1-year Master's scholarship (double diploma)
- Study visit at German partner universities

All scholars complete an internship and are promoted and supervised in special training programs

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Content

- Living expenses grant and / or tuition fee (proportionately where applicable)
- Start money, fixed disturbance allowance, preliminary intensive German language course
- Intensive support by those responsible for the program and the regional company

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Services

- Placement of practical jobs (practical training, student trainings, diploma thesis/dissertation)
- Procedure for obtaining work and residence permits
- Support with visa
- Financial support for obtaining accommodation where the practical training takes place
- Participation in TOPAZ regional groups
- Intercultural seminar
- Consultation, information, support
